Dear Councillors

After the Agenda for the Ordinary Meeting of Council to be held this evening was published, Council received correspondence from the Department of Home Affairs regarding Citizenship Ceremonies. The correspondence is attached.

Councillors may consider the correspondence relevant to *Item 9.4 – Response to Notice of Motion No 5/2023 – Australia Day Citizenship Ceremonies – Newport Beach* on the Agenda.

The correspondence includes the following information:

- As of 31 May, Northern Beaches Council has 476 conferees waiting between 3 to <6 months and 149 conferees waiting between 6 to <12 months for a ceremony.
- It is anticipated that citizenship application rates and approvals will increase in the next
 financial year and Council should therefore work towards clearing current numbers on hand
 with future ceremonies ideally accommodating conferees approved since the last ceremony
 (where possible).

Council staff are now reviewing how this request may be accommodated. There are three ceremonies scheduled for the following dates: 10 July, 14 August and 28 August. We were planning to invite 170 conferees to each ceremony. If the ceremonies proceed with the proposed number of conferees, our waitlist will reduce slightly, however it will not ensure parity over the next 6 – 12 months. That is, the number of applications approved will continue to exceed the number of additional conferees.

Following further review, we will provide a further update.

Hi Rachel

It was a pleasure meeting you on Monday and thank you again for your time.

As of 31 May, Northern Beaches Council have 476 conferees waiting between 3 to < 6 months and 149 conferees waiting between 6 to <12 months. We have noted that three ceremonies have been scheduled for coming months - 10 July, 14 August and 28 August - and you anticipate 170 conferees will be invited to each one. Should these ceremonies proceed with the proposed number of conferees, your waitlist will reduce slightly, however it will not ensure parity over the next 6 to 12 months (the number of applications approved will continue to exceed the number of acquisitions). As we discussed on Monday, it is anticipated that citizenship application rates and approvals will increase in the next financial year. The council should therefore should work towards clearing current numbers on hand with future ceremonies ideally accommodating conferees approved since the last ceremony (wherever possible).

There are many different approaches to the organisation and delivery of ceremonies. For example, some councils do not carry out individual presentation of certificates to conferees during their ceremonies, particularly for larger ceremony groups. This allows councils to increase (and in many cases double) the number of conferees invited to a ceremony. It also shortens the time taken to run a ceremony and allows additional ceremonies to be run back-to-back. There is also no formal requirement for a photographer to be present at a ceremony and where no photographer is present conferees can choose to take their own photos at the conclusion of the ceremony.

Our team are able to generate a new PVL with additional conferees prior to a ceremony. It is recommended that at least four weeks' notice is provided prior to a ceremony date to allow sufficient time for additional conferees to be notified and certificates to be printed and dispatched.

In regards to providing assistance, our team are happy to attend to assist with registration particularly while the council is working to decrease on hand number and time taken for conferees to attend a ceremony. We simply ask that you provide us with sufficient advance notice.



Last three months of application approvals vs number of acquisitions for this council.


