#### RECOMMENDATION

That Council acknowledges the tragic event that occurred at Bondi Beach on Sunday 14 December 2025 and expresses its sincere condolences to the families, friends and the many involved, and acknowledges the first responders, the NSW Police and emergency services personnel.

**BACKGROUND**

Like so many, I was incredibly shocked and saddened to watch the events unfold at Bondi on Sunday 14 December 2025 and the news that so many had lost their lives with many others in hospital dealing with critical injuries.

On behalf of Council and the Northern Beaches community, I want to extend my deepest sympathies to the families and friends who have lost loved ones. Our thoughts are also with the families and friends of those in hospital as they come to terms with the heart-breaking reality that is before them.

For those within our own community who have been impacted by the event and for others, the sheer tragedy of the event can be disturbing and stressful. Our thoughts are with the Jewish community at what should be a time of happy celebrations at the beginning of Hannukah, they are now in mourning.

We acknowledge and thank the incredible efforts of our first responders and the immediate community members who risked their own lives to save others.

As I said yesterday in a statement, there is simply no place for such acts of hatred and violence in Australia - today we take strength in our community and support for one another.

Events such as these are incomprehensible and there are no words that can ever ease the sense of loss and sadness at this time.
